- (e) To provide, for the benefit of Aboriginal people, counseling and referral services to victims of crime;
- (f) To provide, for the benefit of Aboriginal people, wellness services;
- (g) To provide support services, other than family court work, to Aboriginal families;
- (h) To provide, for the benefit of Aboriginal people, alcohol and drug counseling;
- (i) To provide, for the benefit of Aboriginal people, sexual abuse prevention programs;
- (j) To provide, for the benefit of Aboriginal people, employment counseling services; and
- (k) To administer program funding for family wellness programs for the benefit of Aboriginal people.
